

Ahmeek Coppermine Camp ('ACC')
Camp Rules

Campsites and cabins must be maintained and left clean upon departure. Please **dispose of waste in the property dumpster or in trash cans** located throughout the campground. Do not dispose of gray or black water anywhere on the property.

Disorderly, dangerous and unlawful behavior will not be tolerated.

Alcohol may not be consumed by anyone under 21 years of age.

Other controlled substances of any kind are not permitted on the premises.

Driving ORV's while drinking is strictly prohibited to ensure the safety of other campers.

Absolutely no discharge of firearms.

Violators will be asked to leave immediately.

Quiet hours are between 10:00 PM and 7:00 AM. No one may cause any noise which unreasonably disturbs others' enjoyment of the campground. Excessively loud noise (such as loud music, revving engines, barking dogs, generators, yelling/screaming) will not be tolerated at any time. Complaints will be addressed immediately and repeat violators will be asked to vacate the property immediately without refund.

ACC is **pet friendly**, however pets must always be on a 6-ft leash, not tied to trees, and never left unattended. Owners are responsible to clean up after their pets. Because ACC is obligated to ensure everyone's peace and safety, **excessively barking or aggressive pets will not be permitted to stay.**

No fires outside clearly designated Campfire pits/rings OR on days when the risk of forest fires are high.

Do not cut trees. **Only use fallen wood for fires.** Gasoline and other accelerants are prohibited as a fire starter.

Campfires must never be left unattended and should be put out with water, sand or dirt before you sleep/leave.

Fireworks are prohibited.

No metal detecting without prior approval and permit purchase.

No road vehicles allowed on ORV trails. **Stay on clearly marked roads** and obey all traffic signs.

No parking on campsite roads or trails. Obey all traffic signs.

Up to **one vehicle and 2 ORV's** may be parked at your site as space allows. Any other vehicles and trailers must be parked in one of the overflow parking areas.

Racing and speeding ORVs are strictly prohibited on the property. ORVs are prohibited to travel along the power line easement or to trespass on neighbors' properties - they must stay on the campground or on official ORV trails.

ORV drivers and cyclists under 12 yrs **must wear helmets** while riding on campsite property.

ORVs driven on the campground **after dark MUST have headlights turned on** and travel at idle speed.

ACC is **not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged property/vehicles.** Please ensure your vehicles and personal property are properly secured while you are away.

The campground is not equipped with emergency supplies or equipment. **For any kind of emergency, dial 911.** For non-emergency concerns, call the ACC management at (906) 767-8121
